Words from Our Senior Pastor, Dr. Dan Lanier

Beloved Church Family,

Welcome to Worship! Today is going to be a great celebration of Jesus! Bro. Paul, the choir, and all of us here are going to sing praises to our wonderful Lord Jesus! We are going to open God's Word and hear about the Lord Jesus and an invitation will be given to invite people to come to the Lord Jesus! Everything that occurs here today will exalt the Lord Jesus! Church is all about JESUS! It is my prayer that as each one of us leaves this campus today we can say, "I have been in the presence of King Jesus!"

Page 7: add SECTION III ADMISSION BY LETTER

Any person, who has been baptized into the fellowship of a church of like faith and order, shall be received into our fellowship upon request of church letter from church of like faith and order and is in good standing within that fellowship.

Page 7: under Admission by Statement third line next to last word change "may" to "shall."

Page 17: Article VI Meetings Section I Business Meetings: Change first line last word from "Morning" to "Evening."

So it reads:

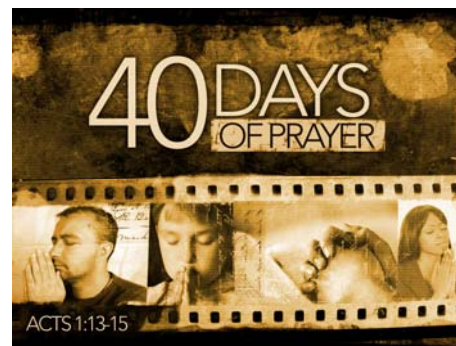
